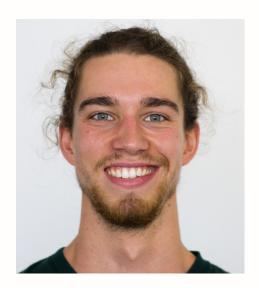
## CURRICULUM VITAE
